Trucks must be on weighbridge by no later than 2:00pm

SITE PROCEDURES

- 1 Enter through GP Security Gate
- 2 Proceed to weighbridge for tare
- 3 Proceed to staging lane
- 4 Proceed to load out canopy
- 5 Sign docket and follow signs to exit gate



SITE SAFETY INFO

Personal Protective Equipment

- Hard hats (if outside vehicle)
- Safety glasses (if outside vehicle)
- Safety boots (steel-cap)
- High-visibility clothing (Australian Standards compliant)
- Long sleeves and pants required if outside of the truck
- Shorts and a shirt are not permitted.
- P2 dust masks (if airborne dust present)

Online induction

- Drivers who do not complete the online induction will not be able to collect from Lascelles Wharf

Safety Rules

- Drivers must communicate over radio before entering shed
- All trucks must have roll over tarps
- As this terminal is in a quarantine site, any carrier that arrives on site with an unclean truck (wheat, barley etc.) will be turned away
- Do not wander around site unescorted
- Comply with Traffic Management Plan
- Obey all speed and warning signs
- Be aware of uneven surfaces, slip and trip hazards
